

[Living Room]

- old Joe Wright has a wooden box thing & wishes for barted eggs
Louise, yr friend, works for him as a cook.

- talk to Louise (ask Louise abt "doesn't work") (he lives on Wickham St, N of park,
at #58 by skate park) g. (where's key)

[1. Drop it, 2. Ask directly, 3. Be subtle] 3 → he keeps a key outside but will hidden
talk to Louise (box is under the bed) g. (He's a very light sleeper; he wakes when I open
the door.) (exit N) N → [Old Joe's garden] window, front door, flowerpots,
rocks, doormat, stone, grass. x door (letterbox, peephole, doorbell, doorknob).

x path (weeds, flystones) left flystone (key!)
unlock door (dog barks; y push it outside;) [Hallway] pictures, red carpet & walls.

N (no) (S & up) { no door (or letterbox) on this side }

U [Staircase] pictures, U/D, hear Joe go to bathroom.

U [Upstairs hallway] (map show N, W, D)

N [Bedroom] bed is wedged in corner by window. lock under bed. take box.

S. hide under bed. z* listen. x window (open) { S.W. (Joe thinks Joe is still in bedhead)

{ exit go down stairs } go out window (not 'enter' or 'out' or 'go through')
→ [Old Joe's garden] (no dog?) open box (the end).
