Alison Meldrew (1871-1930) -- alias "Marie Swelldon"; collected lucky charms; advertized for 2-headed coin; never found 5-leaf clover rumored in County Donegal; installed fake wall south end of attic east wing; push it aside to reach her writing room (husband disapproved). [wrote novel]

Anton Smyslov -- chess grandmaster; won Paris Open for 5 yrs in 1930s; bold sacrificial attacks; ate blueberry yoghurt at the board.

Capability (1761-1817) -- gardener; fashion for crypts and memorials; real name was Willard.

Gerard Meldrew (1898-1916) -- Roger's eldest; killed in Battle of the Somme; mother "Marie Swelldon" gave up writing soon after Gerard's death. [on memorial of Great War 1914-18, 2nd Lt. of 19th/21st Rifles.]
