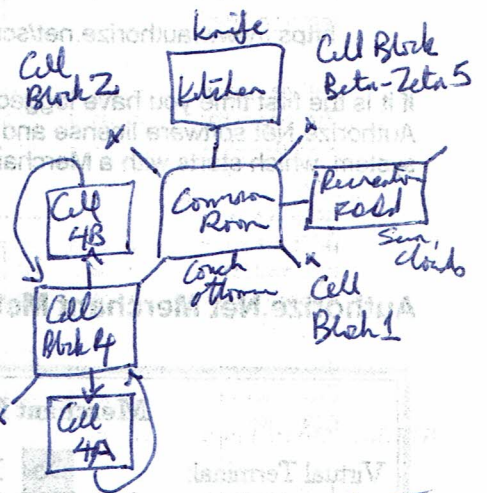

Virtual Terminal Overview

The Virtual Terminal should be used for handling entry of transactions on the Authorize.Net system. Some of the reasons you might need to use Virtual Terminal are:

- You received an order by phone, fax or mail and need to expedite the transaction.
- You need to perform a credit transaction according to your own return policy.
- You previously received a voice authorization by phone and now need to submit the transaction to be captured. (Also called a Post-authorization.)

As you can see, the Virtual Terminal allows you to do many different kinds of transactions, including credit returns (for refunding money to a customer's credit card), authorization only, post-authorized only, and of course a normal authorization. You don't need to have a web site to use Virtual Terminal. Simply login to Authorize.Net and choose Virtual Terminal on the Merchant Menu.
