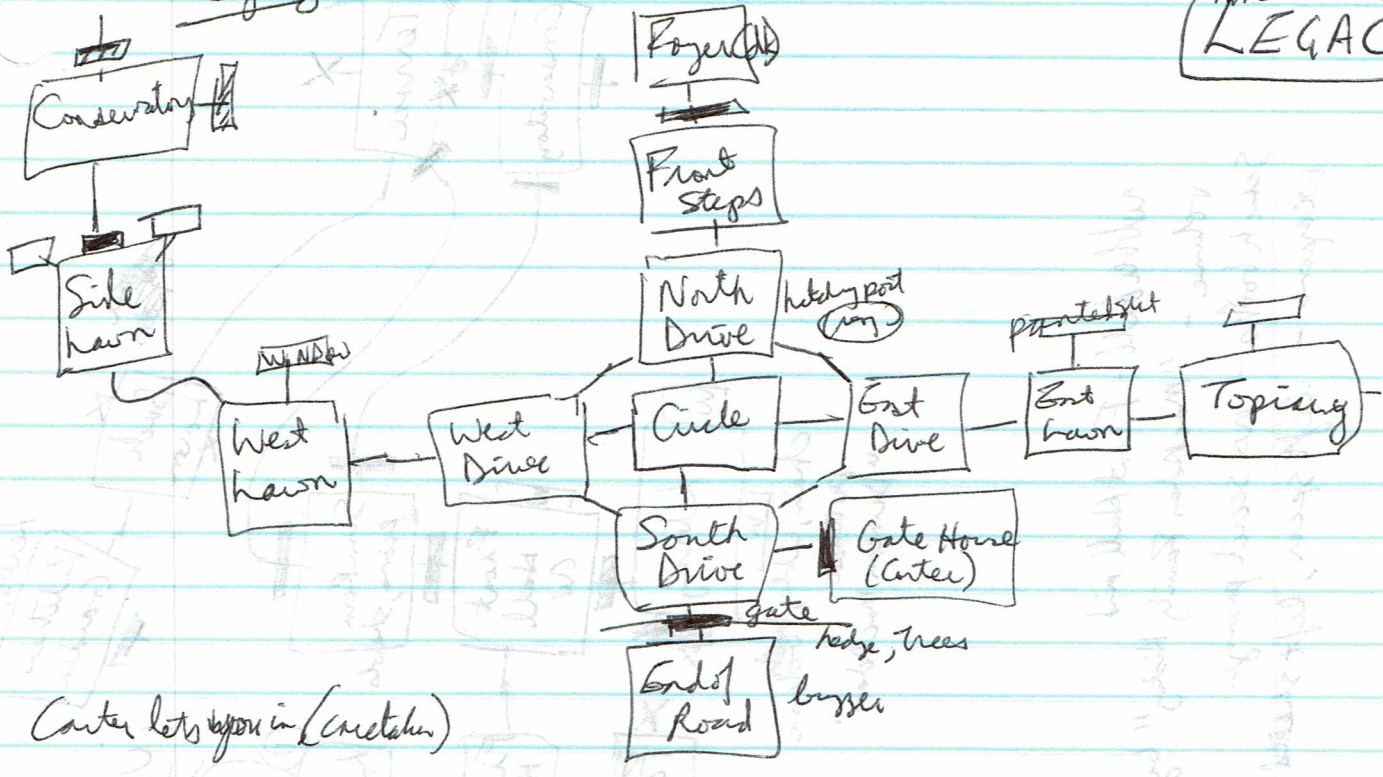


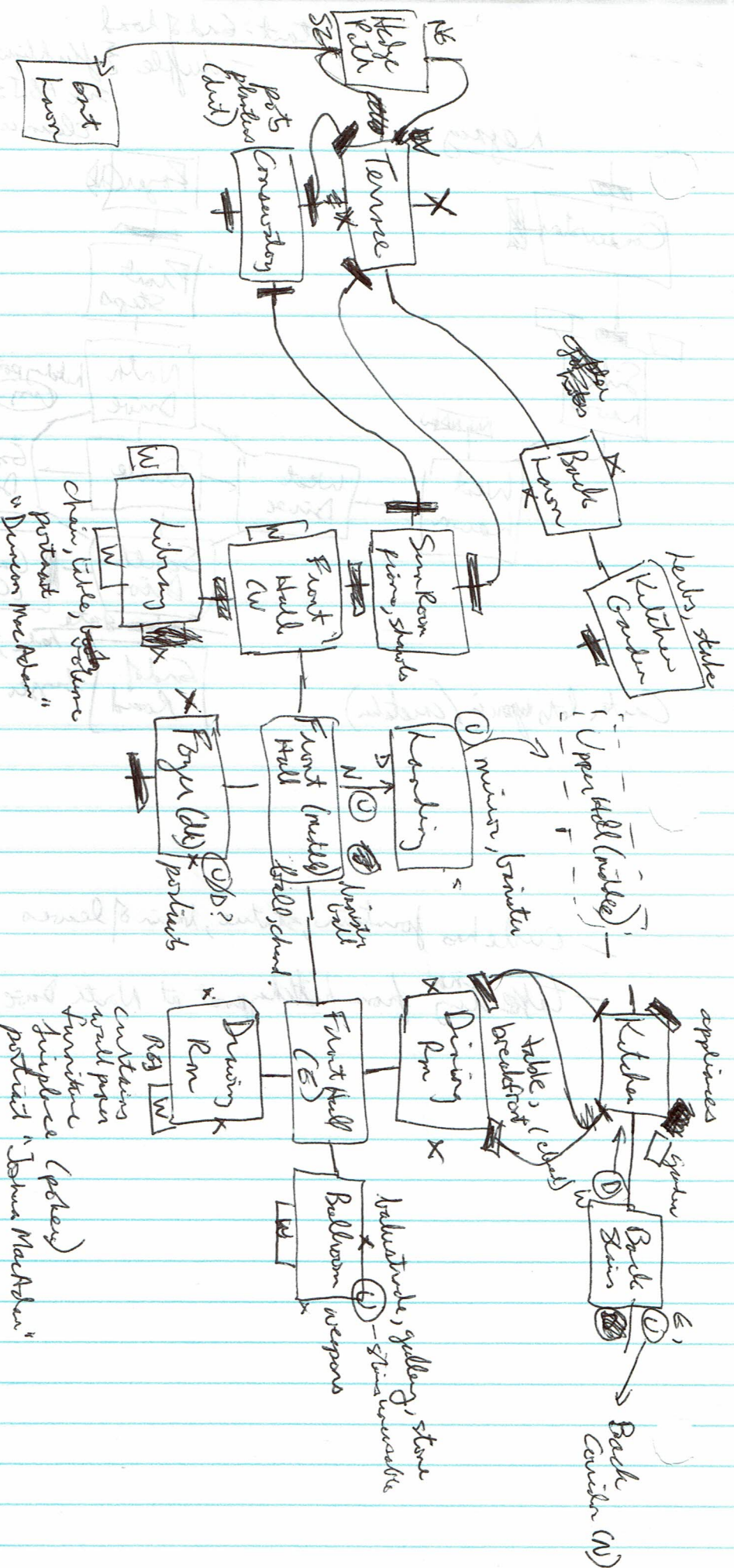

x portrait ("Duncan MacAdam" : sailor?) x volume ("MacAdam Family History", 1965, by Clinton MacAdam)

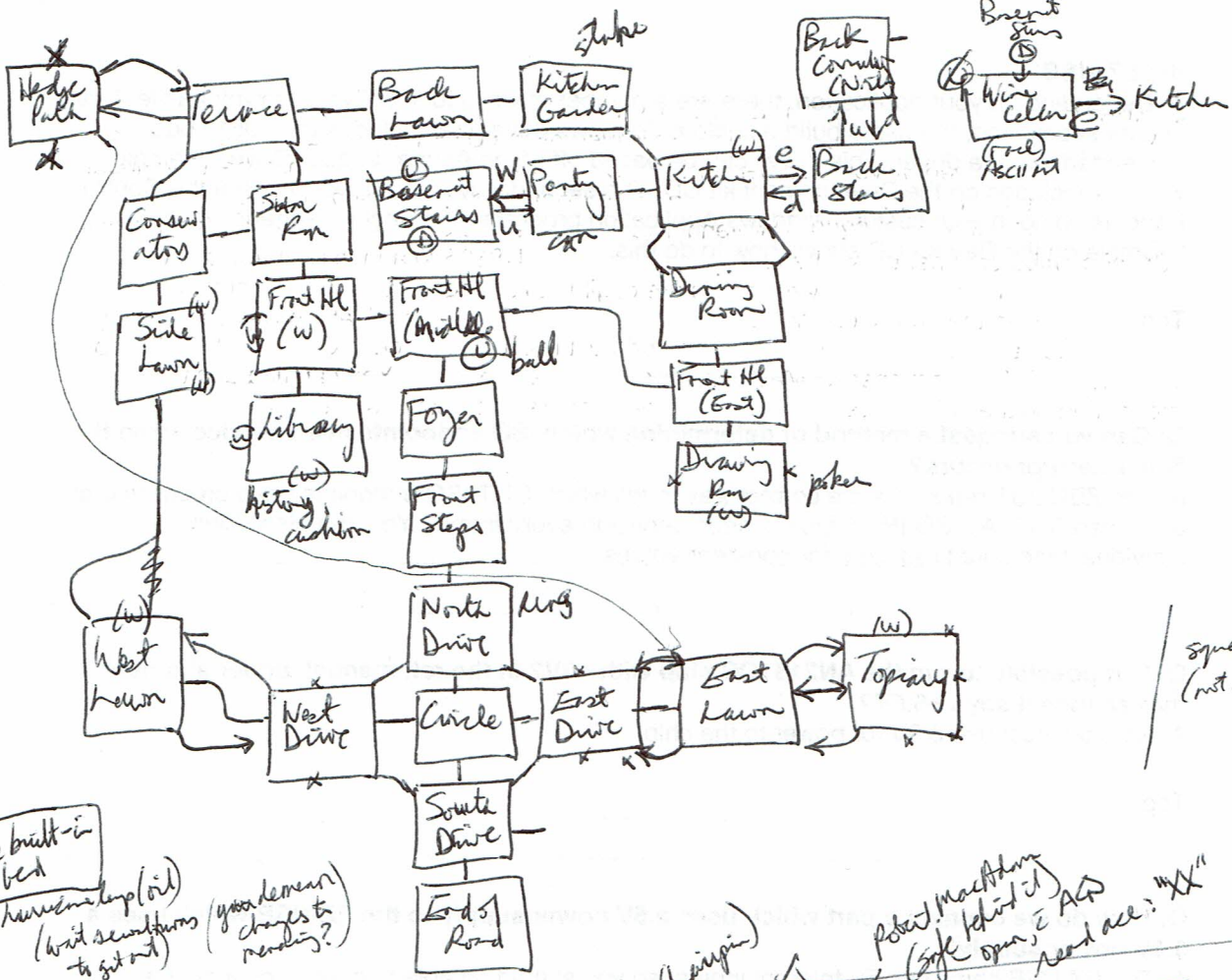
read it: - Cliffhouse btt 1754, dealt in slave trade, gun running, bootlegging

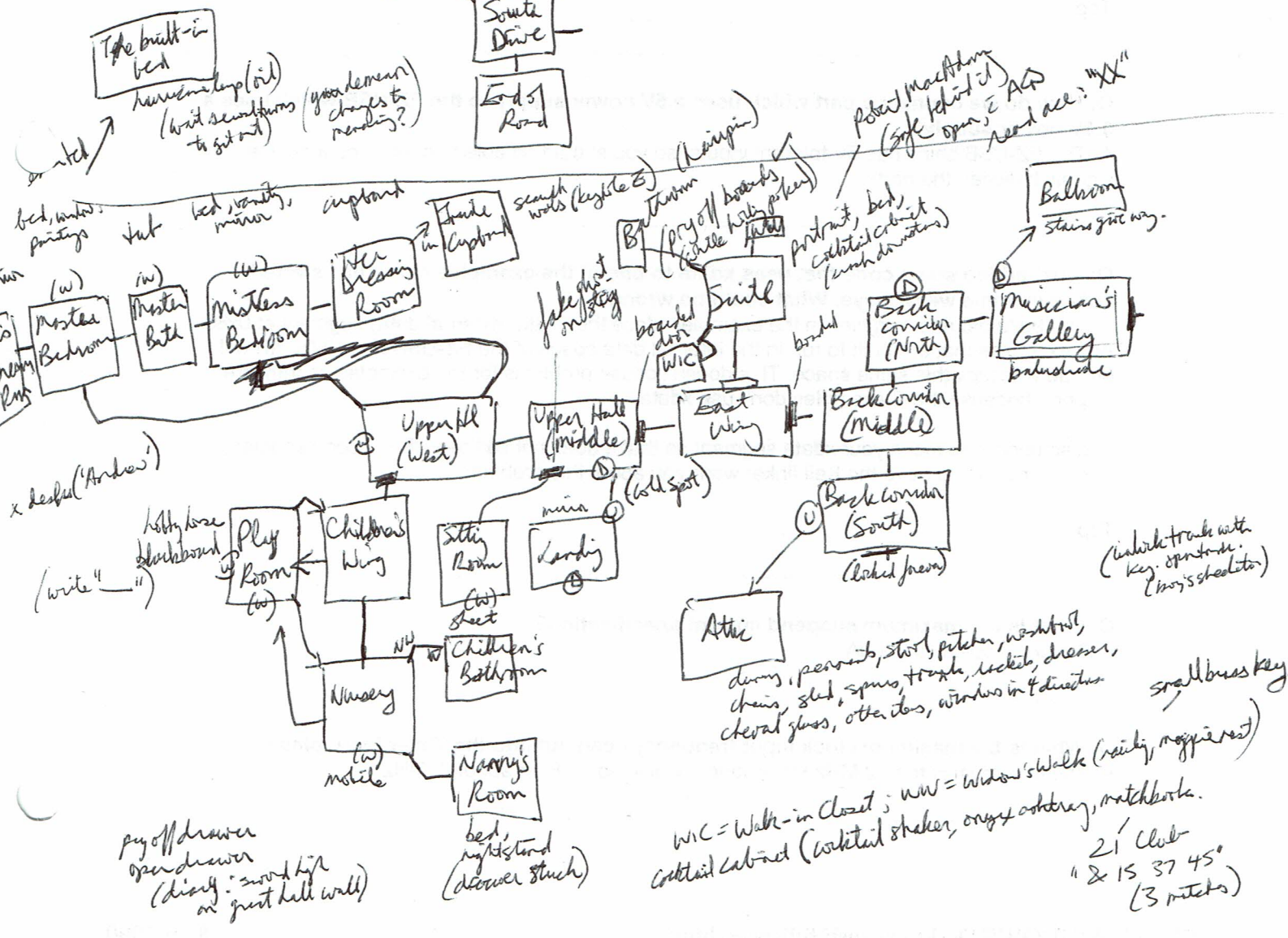
consult history abt Joshua MacAdam (1759-1806, wharfed slave galley, afraid of water, drowned in battle) (son Bruce inherited)

consult history abt Cliffhouse (1754, ballroom from Scottish castle, master below has ship parts; Henry MacAdam commissioned the fountain)

set on chair - search chair (Whopie cushion)



squeeze took gate
(not: put took gate on toothbrush)



pay off drawer open drawer (dial: sword hilt on just hall wall)

w/c = Walk-in Closet; nw = widow's walk (rainy, mopperest) cabinet cabinet (whitetail shaker, orange corkery, matchbooks. 21' clear & 15 37 45 (3 meters))

(circular trunk with key: open trunk. (Mrs's skeleton))
