

N => [South Drive] drive curbs NE + NW, mansion N (turnst), gate has E

pulling (get it) x ring (4-5" wide) N => [Front Steps] door x door (Kerosene shaped like sailing ship)




doors SW + SE. break in hedge W.. E => [Back Lawn] E/W, gopher holes E => [Kitchen Garden] herbs, ~~wooden~~ door S, stake
S => (dk) [Kitchen] tiles, gas appliances, windows NE, dr NW, doorways E+W, swing doors SE+SW.

W => [Basement Stairs] U+D, E. // [Dining Room] tbl, breakfast ~~table~~ (closed) // [Drawing Rm] furniture, window, fireplace, portrait
x portrait ("Joshua MacAdam") x fireplace (poker) // [Library] portrait, chair, tbl, slim volume, books

x portrait ("Duncan MacAdam" : sailor?) x volume ("MacAdam Family History", 1965, by Clinton MacAdam)
read it: - Cliffhouse btt 1754, dealt in slave trade, gun running, bootlegging
consult history abt Duncan MacAdam (1857-1913, Cpt, shipped guns, killed in mining, Cliffhouse parcel to mother and Phoebe.
consult history abt Joshua MacAdam (1759-1806, wharfed slave galleys, afraid of water, drowned in battle) (son Bruce inherited)
consult history abt Cliffhouse (1754, ballroom from Scottish castle, master below has ship parts; Henry MacAdam commissioned the fountain)

set on chair. search chair (Whopie cushion)
