pity she disc'd facts of his end."


Journal - describes treasure: "Moonmist" drug taken from rare Amazon plant called

her red necklace beside well. Jack c elec. torch found green fabric on well bricks.

Police concluded she drowned. Divers never found the body.

lionel - strange bird

Jack - not my place to say

8:30

under bed - tape recorder & clockwork

• "Good evening, all" (heir's voice)

"You are all here, I trust, to honor the wish expressed in my will -

that the seven of you should dine together at T. Castle on the evening of my birthday"

[Jack, Iris, Viv, Montague, Ian, Wendish, Deidre]

"... loss of that valuable artifact, which I bought back from one of my expeditions."

Under punchboard:

1st clue shows an Amazon hunter, aiming a blowgun at the tree tops.

- 2nd clue is Jack's (?) + butler's note.

"So now, my friends, let the game begin"

- 3rd clue:

"My fist is an 'I', but find an 'eye' that sees not."

Note :

- all servants left at sound of dinner gong. (not back until morning)

- Gladys, upstairs maid, won't be back (see note on writing desk in sitting room)

- in ~~Moving~~ room - portrait of Deidre by Vivien (wearing gown of accident,
standing at slope looking to sea).

Yellow Variation [2, 3]

1st clue: photo of singer Pearl Bailey.
[Under punchbowl]

2nd clue: "... Yet the ear distinctly tells, ...
How the danger sinks and swells,
By the sinking or the swelling in the anger of the ____ s..."
[Jack has it]

3rd clue: "... And so, all the night-tide, I lie down by the side
Of my darling - my darling - my life and my bride, ...
In her tomb by the sounding sea.
[in bell at Fighting Deck]

4th clue: "If you search for 'A Cask of Amontillado,'
don't get trapped!"
[in stone coffin at Secret Tomb]

Evidence: 1) tiny red jewel [scout carpet in Drawing Room]
2) earring [in jewelry case in Tamara's Bedroom]
POT jewel in EARRING for evidence

Wendell's Bedroom

- medieval texts, dressing table, medical kit, marble-topped console, ornate candle sconce

Master Bedroom

- canopy 4-poster bed on circular dias
- marble-topped console and mirror
- 2 oversized wardrobes, cheval glass, tallboy, commode, overstuffed chair, color TV
- telescope on swinging wall bracket near small window

Vivien's Bedroom

- sketches, garments on canopy bed & chaise longue.
- canvases & fold-up easel, tallboy, sketch pad
- wooden box, cheval glass, sculpted figurine.
[Inside wooden box is plastic box holding second easel]

Tan's Bedroom

- rich wood paneling, 4-poster bed, Victorian washstand, redining Morris chair. Fireplace has fleathy grillwork, & andirons have fancy heads

Hyde's Bedroom

- many tasteful antiques, such as armchair

ASK BOB THO ABOUT D.R.D.R.E

- sent to find her
- found tent pole + shoe in front of well.
- shoe's spike heel wrenched bone
- red necklace beside well
- ~~shoe~~ jack shoe took down well + found strand of fabric snugged on brickwork
- body never found.

Lobby

- bookcase/history book, table/reading lamp, chair, armchair, fireplace.

Green Variation

1st clue: shows Amazon hunter, aiming a blowgun at the tree tops.

[found under punchbowl in Dining Room]

2nd clue: "My first is an 'I', but find an 'eye' that sees not.

[Jack has 2nd clue]

3rd clue: "My second is in never but not in ever,
and lies in a hidden 'end'."

[behind glass eye of head of rhino in Game Room]

4th clue: "My ~~first~~ third is the silent side of knight.

All together I am what you could use for poison - per letters."

[on floor in "DeadEnd" of first floor's secret passages.]

Treasure: INK inside inkwell on desk in Office.

The "ink" is the Moonmist drug taken from a rare Amazon plant called Moonflower. Natives use it to tip poison darts, but it is also medicine. Must gather plant only when full moon is misted over. [described in journal in Office]

Evidence: 1) contact lens [search New Great Hall floor]

2) lab notebook [in bookcase in Library]

- incriminates Dr. Wendish re: Wendish experiments at clinic:

"Finally took case of Poldark's granddaughter. (comely wench),
pity she disc'd fits of his end."

Blue Variation [0,1]

1st clue: shows skeleton in Chinese mandarin costume.

[under punchbowl]

2nd clue: "Three fellows argued about life:

1. "Using this motto, no chap can go wrong:
Leave the wench and the grape, but go with a —!"
2. "On the seas of my life sails a ship that is laden
Not with bottles or tunes, but with innocent — s!"
3. "Women and singing are both very fine,
But for me there is nothing to equal good — !"

[Jack has it; SONG, MAIDEN, WINE]

2A: [on piece of music, on piano, in Sitting Room]

Beethoven's "Suite No. 9" has star in red ink over
just for letters of the word "SUITE"

2C: [on wine bottle, in Attic, in Basement]

"Old Own Vintage". Red star ~~is~~ on "OUR".

2B: [stand in iron maiden, in Dungeon]

→ leads to Secret Tomb [containing stone coffin]

3rd clue: "My al— has no glamour;

It's ' — e' tones do clam — .

Can you find me?"

[inside helmet of suit of armour, in New Great Hall]

Treasure: [fossil skull inside bell at Fighting Deck]

2B: [maiden on tapestry in Drawing Room]

star in red thread on the maiden's Aprt.

Evidence: 1) contact lens [on floor of New Great Hall]

bens - Tamara [never worn glasses or lenses]

Vivien [glasses for art, but contacts - ouch!]

Iris ["Good Lord! I think you're onto something here."]

Tan [not mine. Guards can't have bad eyesight.]

Hyde [shows monocle; only aid I require.]

Wendish [not mine. Wear glasses all the time.]

Jack [puzzled shug; nothing wrong with my eyesight.]

plastic box - Vivien [claims not hers, planted on her (but she flinched)]

Iris [Good Lord! I think you're onto something here.]

Wendish [I say!] "I say, it's a dog."

Hyde [Good Lord! "]

[Moll turns off light, moves to window]

dark Vivian: [turn sculpted figurine]


Iris:

Red Variation

1st clue: shows King of Clubs in one corner, with a picture of an African chief holding a war club; in the other corner is the King of Diamonds, with a picture of a crowned vulture clutching a diamond [under punchbowl]

2nd clue: "Forbidden fruit tempted the very first loes.
'Twas once in a garden but now in a glass."
[Vivien has it]

3rd clue: "Despite its appearance, the fruit was quite sour.
One bite of the apple drove Eve from her bower."
[stuck on apple on stained glass window in Chapel]

Evidence: 1) tiny red jewel [search carpet in drawing room]
