9 CUT LINE WITH JACKKNIFE

10 TURN FAUCET

11 PULL PLUG

## VISIT THE MANSION OF SPEAKING [17]

Before the Manor [Interior Decorated, Kremlin, Doldrums, Pharmacy, Attic]  
- attic is currently below 1st floor.
