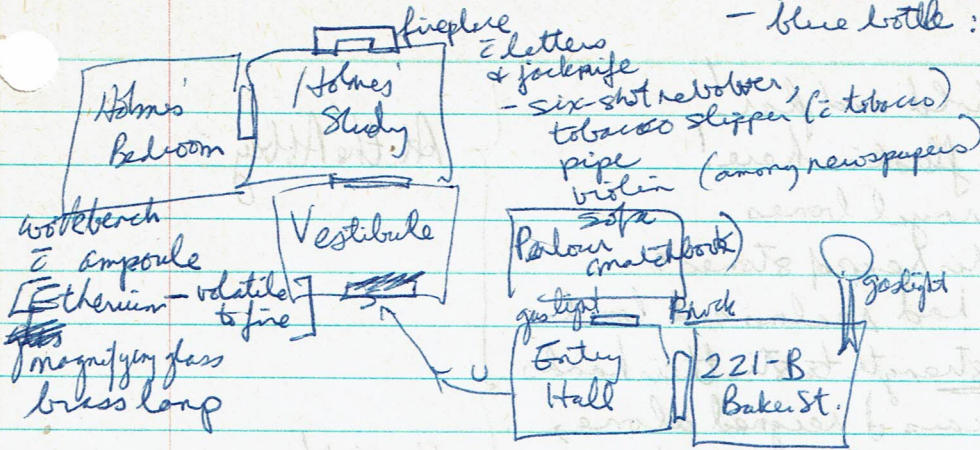

waxhead of Charles can be unscrewed from statue
light head with torch \Rightarrow take EMERALD (+5)

Show EMERALD to Holmes \Rightarrow not a crown jewel; belongs to Agatassene which was stolen in India years ago. Gives you signet ring.

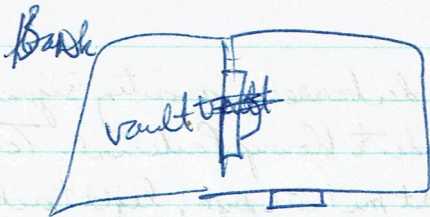

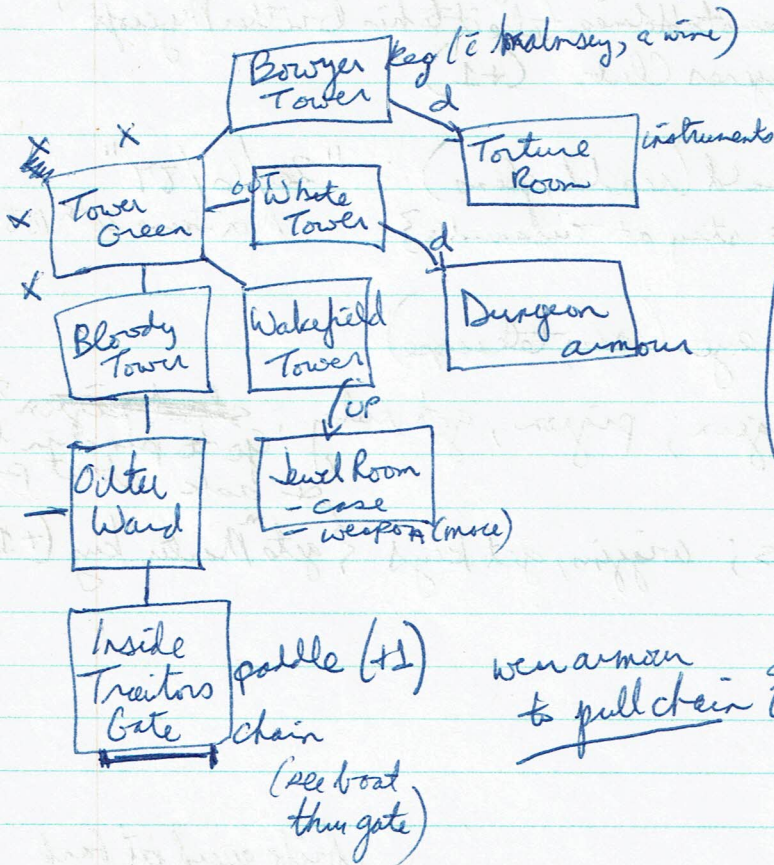

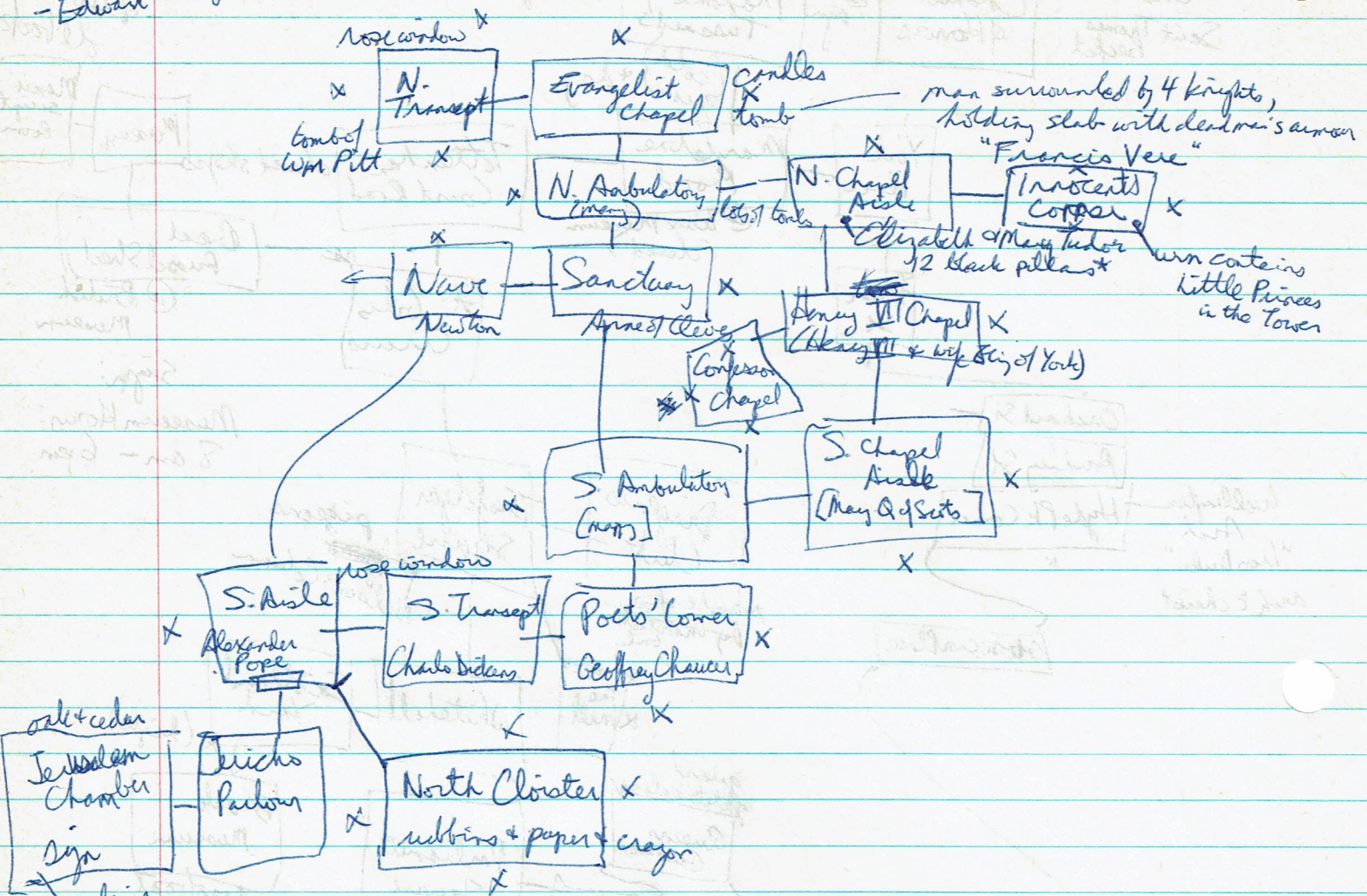
