smell the prostitute. 1. { buried beneath her clients; can hardly smell her among them }
 5 guests (via dining room) { front door, back door, no guests the week as far as butler knows }
 5 bath-door { tiled floor + joint between two fixtures is bloody }
 5 front { not much, evidence of a struggle } 5 struggle { someone stepped in, stabbed, & then carried or dragged away }.

- prostitute killed while butler slept?

// 5 colors (via posture): Capt wears kidskin gloves { jacket, cravat, velvet-covered top hat }
 5 jacket { envelope } had letter.
 {{ guessed: BARE AT JERARD = wrong! }}
 {{ BARE AT CAPTAIN = correct! }}

- the prostitute poisoned & blackmailed Gerald; G wrote Capt the letter for help
- while G + V at opera, prostitute came to house & killed by Capt & buried (butler misinterpreted as claret)
- H used Toby to force a confession, bc he didn't have the letter as evidence.
